



Vietnam Art, Culture and Golf Trail 5 Nights / 6 Days

Golf in Vietnam has taken off with more than 40 golf courses in Danang, Saigon, Hanoi and other locations. Of these, it is the Danang golf courses that are the biggest drivers of golf tourists to Vietnam. A quick glance at them easily suggests why.

Golf in Vietnam is set in incredible landscapes – making it an incomparable feast both visually and golf experience wise. Hilly rainforest landscape, natural water bodies, sandy dunes and sensational sea-vistas are all part of the offering. Hoiana Shores, Laguna Lang Co, Bana Hills, BRG Danang Golf Club, Montgomerie Links, and Vinpearl Nam Hoi An is the current lineup. They comprise a total of 7 – 18 hole layouts with facilities to match and impress the international Golfer.

Day 3:	<p>ROUND 2:</p> <p>GOLFERS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Round of Golf at BRG Kings' Island Course – Lakeside Course (Tee time: 12 noon onwards) <p>NON-GOLFERS/ SPOUSES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Hanoi City Tour: Visit the famous & popular sights of Hanoi such as Ho chi minh's Mausoleum, Ho chi minh's House on Stilts, Ho chi minh Museum. Have lunch at a local restaurant. Then continue on to visiting the Van Mieu – the first university in Vietnam, Fine Art museum, and end with shopping at the Old-Quarter. ● Dinner at the hotel. <p>Overnight in Hanoi.</p>





<p>Day 4:</p>	<p>ROUND 3: Golf Round</p> <p>Round 3 of golf at Hilltop Valley course (Tee time 12 noon onwards)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Evening at leisure <p>NON-GOLFERS/ SPOUSES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tour of the Tam Coc-Bichdong Cave: In the morning, depart from Hanoi to Bichdong Cave which is in the village of Vanlam, a short boat trip away. Bichdong is a beautiful pagoda and the three sanctuaries here date from the 17th century. It is known as the second most picturesque one in Vietnam and inside the caves you find the most fascinating grottoes and stalactites flaunt their wonders hanging like masses of jade. After lunch time, drive back to Hanoi. Evening at leisure. ● Overnight In Hanoi.
<p>Day 5:</p>	<p>ROUND 4 & OVERNIGHT IN HALONG BAY</p> <p>GOLFERS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Round 4 of Golf at Longbien Course Tee Time: 6:20 onwards ● After games, lunch and depart from Hanoi to Ha Long Bay (UNESCO World Heritage Site) ● 15.30 Boarding the Overnight Cruise Boat ● Explore Ho Dong Tien island ● In the evening, Gala Dinner on cruise in Ha Long Bay.

NON-GOLFERS/ SPOUSES:

- Day at leisure or you can take up optional tours
- After games, lunch and depart from Hanoi to Ha Long Bay (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
- 15.30 Boarding the Overnight Cruise Boat
- Explore Ho Dong Tien island
- In the evening, Gala Dinner on cruise in Ha Long Bay.

DISEMBARK CRUISE & DEPART TO AIRPORT:
